outdoor pursuits including walking and cycling.








Education, education, education





Getting around



By foot: The onsite Milltimber school is a 10 minute walk. 20 minutes and you could be in Beildside with its range of trendy bars, cafes and restaurants. Cults Academy can also be reached by foot in less than half an hour.



By car: The cosmopolitan delights of the capital are around a 20 minute drive. And in just 25 minutes you could be enjoying a picnic and swim on Aberdeen's coast. Looking to go further afield? Airport Aberdeen is less than 15 minutes from home.



By train: Services from Aberdeen Train Station reach Dundee in just over an hour, Perth in 1 hour 30 minutes, Edinburgh in 2 hours 21 minutes and Glasgow in 2 hours 35 minutes.



By bus: Local buses serve the area well. As do frequent bus services into Cults and Aberdeen.



As part of our sustainability journey we are aiming to reduce our paper usage by 90% across the company, including the customer journey, which is why we are aiming for online only brochures at our developments.


